Science

We are exploring materials, their properties and changes (reversible and irreversible) Pupils will: determine the hardness of different materials and link this to their uses, determine the transparency of different materials and link this to their uses, determine the thermal and electrical conductivity of different materials and link this to their uses, demonstrate, identify and describe reversible and irreversible changes.

How to help your child's learning:

Please encourage your child to read at least 5 times per week and record their reading in their reading record book. This means we can track their reading, but also means we can talk to your child about what they are reading. Any text is suitable including: books, magazines and newspapers.

Writing

This term our writing will be inspired by "The Dark" by Lemony Snicket. The story is about a young boy called Laszlo who overcomes his fear of the dark. The children will learn to create atmosphere and suspense in their fiction writing. They will also write a diary entry, recording the events from the story and the characters thoughts and feelings. They will learn to use apostrophes for contractions and passive verb forms.

Our class story this term is *Escape Room* by Christopher Edge which is a thrilling adventure story that challenges young readers to solve puzzles while exploring themes of teamwork, bravery, and the importance of protecting our planet.
