It is so important that each child reads **5 times a week**, this may be a set reading book from school linked to their understanding of phonics or may be a larger chapter book of their choosing. Children should be aiming to read a total of 30 times this term, which will be recorded a dojos/certificates awarded for those who complete the challenge.

SATS Booklets (Year 6 only)
