What was the impact of World War II on the people of Britain?



Science

By the end of the unit children will know:

- Some substances will dissolve in a liquid to form a solution.
- The factors that affect the time taken to dissolve, including temperature and stirring.
- Some liquids and solids can be separated using sieving, filtering and evaporation and to describe these processes.

Writing

This term our writing will be inspired by “The Man Who Walked Between the Towers”, a fictitious story based on the actions of Philippe Petit, who in 1974 strung a tightrope between the twin towers in New York City and walked between them unsupported.

The children will rewrite sections of the narrative before inventing their own section where Philippe is questioned by the police upon arresting him. Year 3/4 will write a persuasion to the judge to convince them that he was not a criminal, whilst Year 5/6 will write a discussion summarising the key points of the discussion as to whether or not he was a criminal.
