Y2:

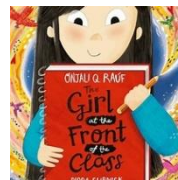
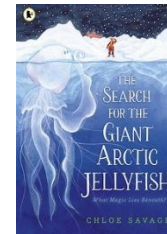
