Ash Class - Reception and Year 1.

Two grids are published on a Tapestry post every Sunday evening.

One grid details the morning, **CORE** activities for each day. There is different provision for Reception and Year 1 according to the children's age and stage in learning.

The second learning grid shows all the **FOUNDATION** activities planned for each day with links to websites and resources.

The Tapestry post gives detailed instructions and links to resources for all activities.

This allows parents to prepare and print learning materials in advance if they choose to do so.
