Daily Activities	Examples of Typical Resources to support Learning
English	EdShed – SpellingShed This term's English work is based on the text: 'Escape from Pompeii' and links to learning in History and Geography.
Maths	White Rose videos (vimeo), YouTube, BBC Bitesize videos and practical activities. Online activities and worksheets set in Google Classroom. Printed worksheets are available on request, where necessary, for collection at the school gate. Maths games suggested (Topmarks). Times Table Rockstars practice – own pupil login. MathShed – using own pupil EdShed login.
Reading practice	Daily Reading practice: Oak National Academy – links provided in Google Classroom. Reading activities set in Google Classroom. Personal reading book.
Foundation activity (At least 1 activity e.g. history, geography, creative.)	This term's geography unit is 'Extreme Earth.' The children will be learning about volcanoes and earthquakes and linking this with their work on Romans from last term. A variety of media will be used to support learning in these areas.
Daily physical activity	Go Noodle, Joe Wicks, Cosmic Yoga.
Collective Worship	1 pre-recorded assembly each week by Mrs Warnock
