This year we are asking for sealed, bought and packaged Harvest Collections for North Bristol & South Glos Foodbank.

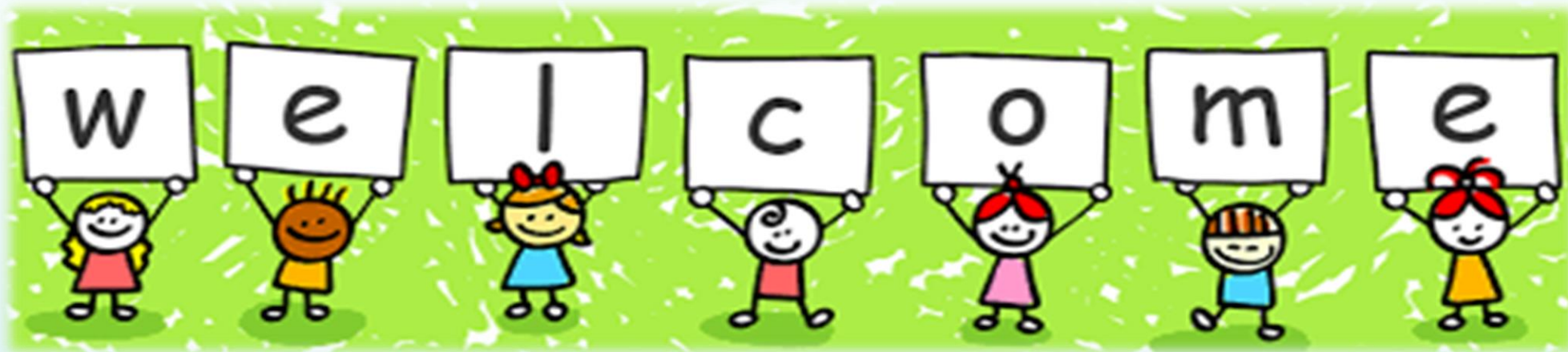
We would like to make a display in the school hall and ask that donations are brought into school during the week beginning 2nd October 2023. (No raw nut products please due to the risk of air born allergens)

Would you like to become a school governor?
A position for a parent governor has become available.



What is a school governor?

Governors are responsible for overseeing the management side of a school: strategy, policy, budgeting and staffing. They enable their school to run as effectively as possible, working alongside senior leaders and supporting teachers to provide excellent education to children.

As a governor you will be a volunteer who makes a vital contribution to the success of the school.

School governors have three main roles.

1. Governors ensure clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction.

The governing body helps to set long-term plans for the school, decide where improvements need to be made and how to make them.

2. Governors hold the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and the effective and efficient performance management of staff.

The governing body looks at the quality of education being offered and ensures the head is doing everything possible to improve results.

3. Governors oversee the financial performance of the school and make sure its money is well spent.

Governors examine budgets and spending proposals to monitor whether the school is getting value for money and ensure the money is spent in the right areas.

Governor meetings are held on a Tuesday evening. Full training is available and governors are encouraged to attend at least 2 training sessions on-line a year.

Governors are committed to safeguarding, all governor roles are subject to a free Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.


