- Wear a tracksuit top, jumper or fleece as the weather turns cooler

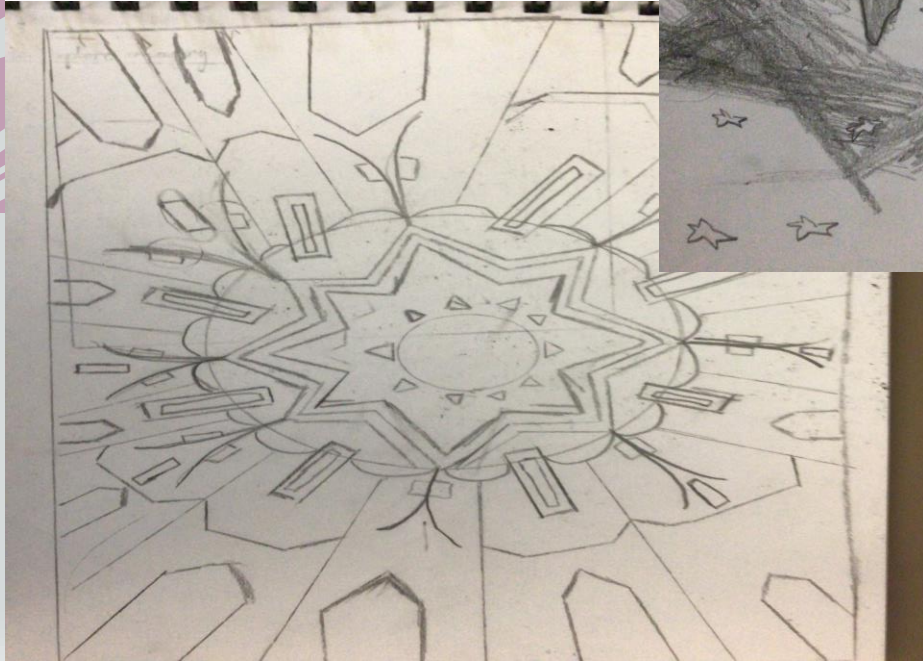
