After School Enrichment Clubs



- Unfortunately, Teachers will no longer be running after school clubs. Teachers
 instead wish to concentrate on ensuring they deliver the best provision possible
 for children within the core school day.
- Alternatively, I have sourced a new company which I wrote to parents about.
 Educationbox provide a variety of clubs and would like to start the year by
 offering Ukuleles (£6.95) and Percussion clubs (£5.95) on a Wednesday and
 Thursday from Year 1 to Year 6. Please let Mrs Smart know in the office if you
 would like to confirm a place 3.15pm to 4.15pm on either or both days this term.
 Pupil Premium Children would be in receipt of a 50% discount for these clubs.
- Furthermore, Swift Sport (our current after school club provider) are willing to run extra clubs on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays 3.15pm to 4.15pm. These would be paid clubs and bookings would be via the Vision for Sport website. Unfortunately, school cannot fund these extra clubs as per the Tuesday and Friday clubs. More details to follow as Vision for Sport would like to gauge interest on the extra days from families before confirming in case the numbers are too low. Pupil Premium Children would be in receipt of a 50% discount for these clubs.

- We look forward to our children being able to show off their amazing potential to staff, children and their families. I do hope you can join us throughout the year









