Uniform Questions

Do parents/carers have to buy coloured t-shirts with House Animal Logos on them?

NO!

Due to pressures that some families are experiencing linked to the increasing cost of living, a plain t shirt is all we ask parents/carers to purchase for PE sessions.

Can children wear ankle boots during the cold weather period?

YES!

Ankle boots are acceptable if they are flat and have no block, raised or wedge heel. However, boots that come up to the knee or just below the knee can be uncomfortable for children when sitting on the carpet and if their feet become hot during the day.

Can children wear school shoes for PE?

NO!

Some school shoes are not appropriate for physical exercise as they do not give the support, comfort and grip that trainers/pumps give during physical movements such as running etc. We do not want to put the health and safety of children at risk during PE sessions. All children must wear trainers or pumps during PE sessions.

Can children wear leggings for PE?

We would prefer children to wear loose joggers for physical exercise sessions as this enables them to move more freely. We also ask parents/carers to consider carefully tight leggings and cycling shorts as children's bodies develop further into Key stage 2 as this can exacerbate problems with body consciousness. Thank you for your understanding on this sensitive issue.
