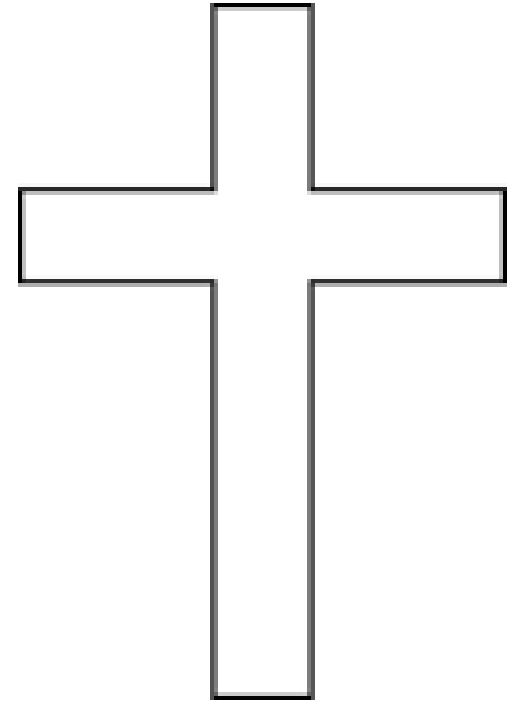

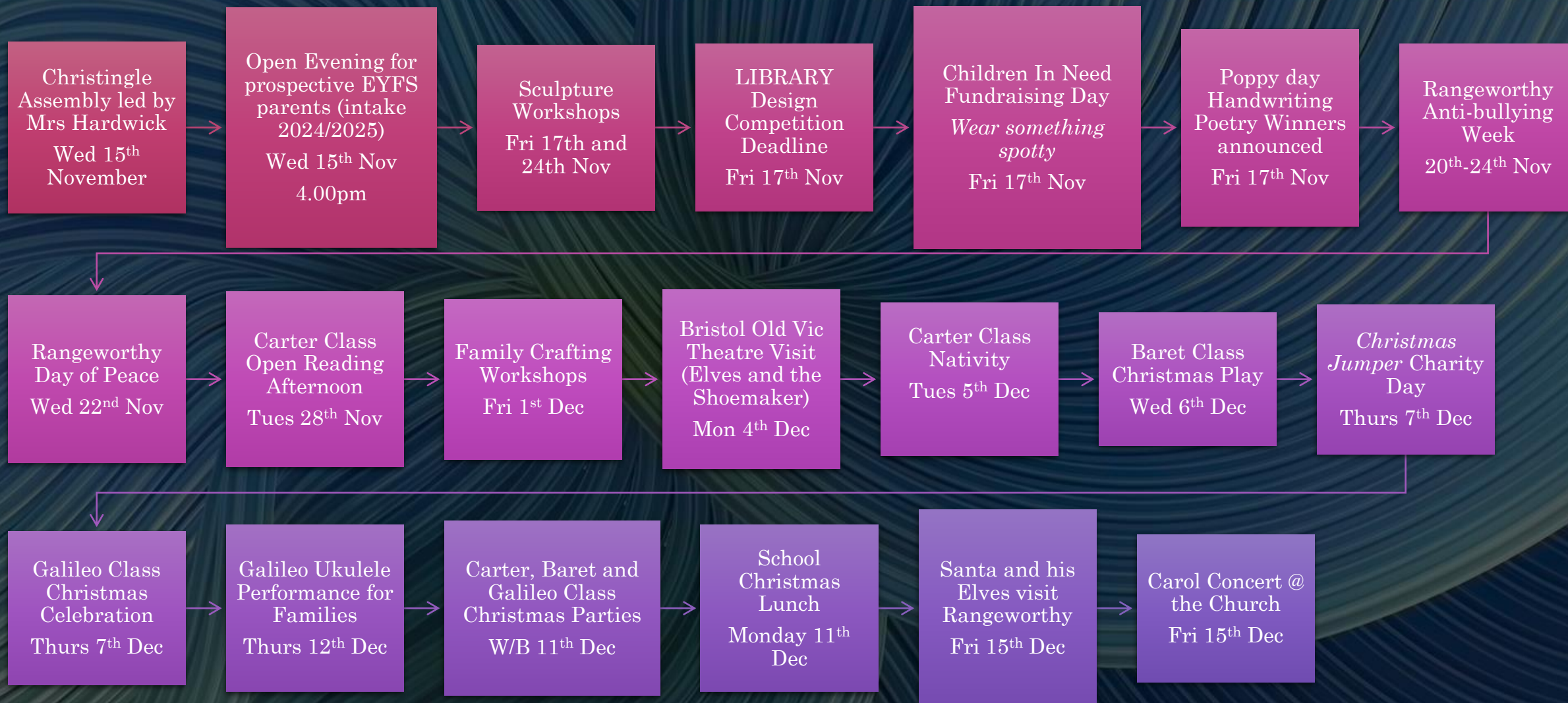

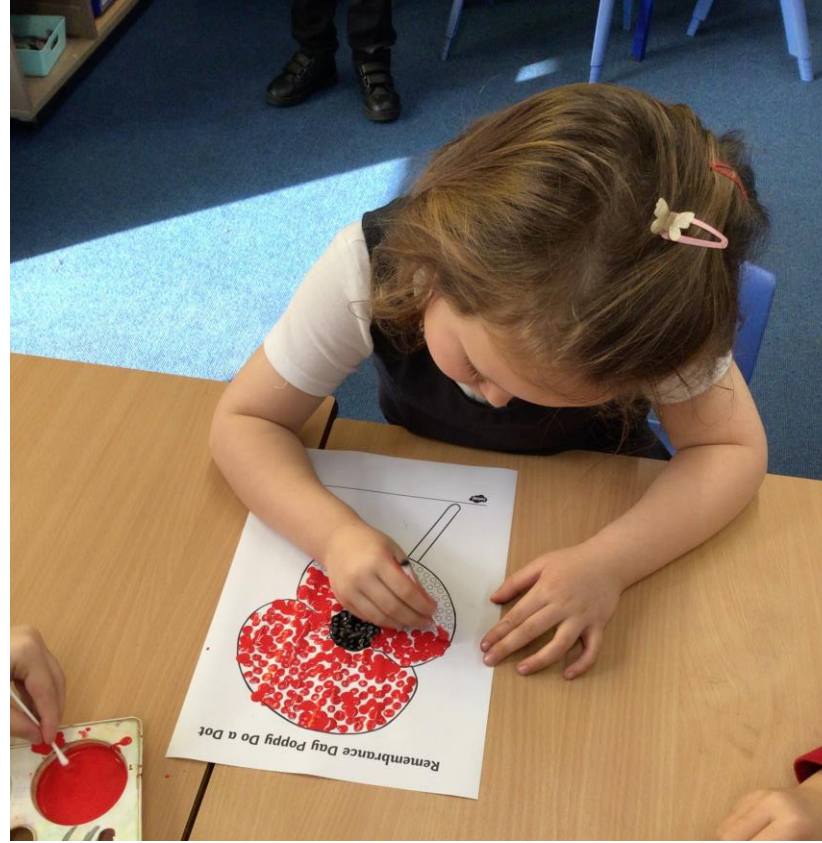


Baret class

The ‘buddies’ will be kept by residents who will put them out in the mornings and afternoons and take them in again when not needed.

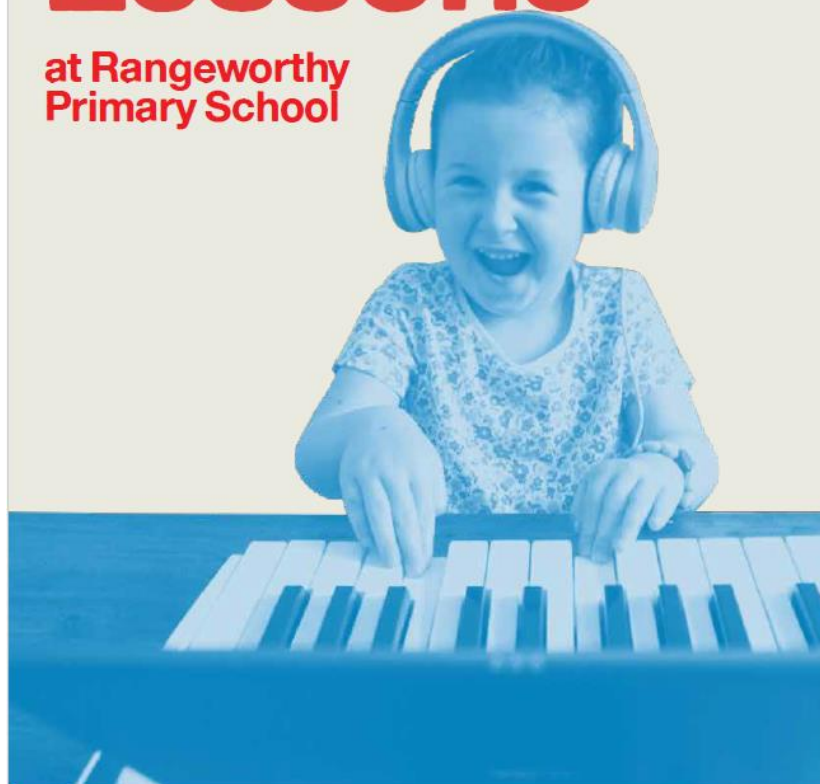

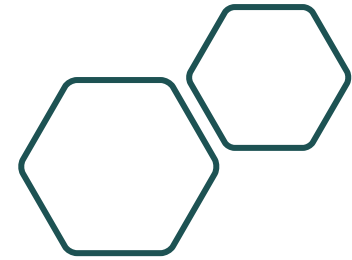
