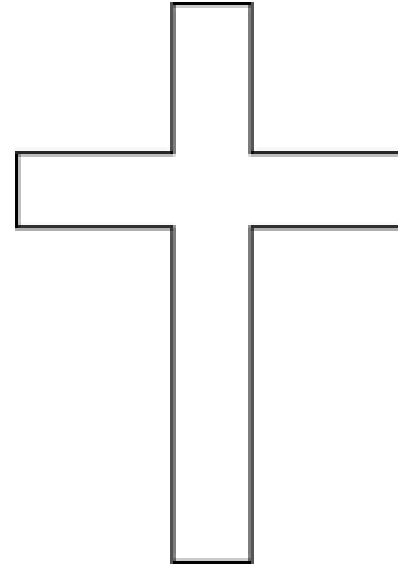

Cycling Training for the 21st Century

SCHOOL HOLIDAY CYCLE TRAINING COURSES

All courses are Subject to a £5 Booking Fee which is Non-Refundable, places are limited, booked on a first come basis, so please do not delay –

ANY CHILD ATTENDING BIKEABILITY TRAINING CAN ONLY ATTEND ONE COURSE DURING THE SPECIFIC HOLIDAY COURSE DURATION

Level 2

Consists of two morning sessions, there is an initial assessment in the playground covering level 1 skills to ensure they are ready for on road training. Once out on the road they will learn about road position, which road user has priority and when, how to recognise typical hazards as well as manoeuvring through junctions. This course is for School years 6 and above.

Level 3

Aims to equip riders with skills for more challenging roads and traffic situations such as passing queuing traffic, road narrowing, understanding blind spots and perceive and deal with hazards. Level 2 must be undertaken prior to Level 3. This course is for school years 6 and above.

- Trainees must have a properly fitted cycle helmet.

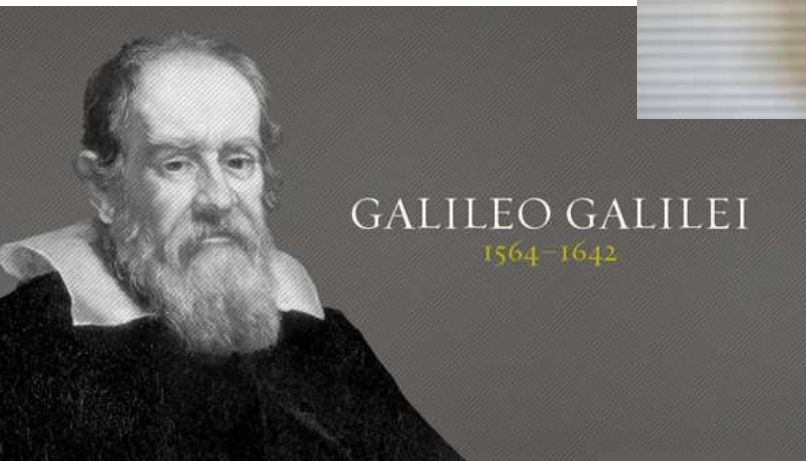
All Instructors are DBS checked and work for the Council's Road Safety Team. ~~Bikeability~~ certificates are awarded to all trainees who successfully complete the course.
